Have You Heard of Homographs?

There are plenty of homographs in the story 'The Live Dinosaur Tour'. A **homograph** is a word that is spelt the same and sounds the same as another word but has a different meaning. Here is an example of a homograph: The word '**cool**' can mean two things:

- The wind is a bit **cool** — means the wind is a bit cold.
- Those shoes are **cool** — means the shoes are very nice.


