

## Follow the Rules Worksheet 1 – Reading Focus

### The Magic 'e'

Have you heard of the Magic 'e'?

Sometimes when you add 'e' to the end of a word, it magically turns a short vowel into a long vowel!

Let's try it!

Put a magic 'e' at the end of these words to change the vowel sound:

When you added a magic 'e' to the word 'hug', the letter 'g' changed its sound also.

In *hug* - the 'g' makes a *hard g* sound but in *huge*, 'g' makes a 'j' sound - this is called *soft 'g'*.

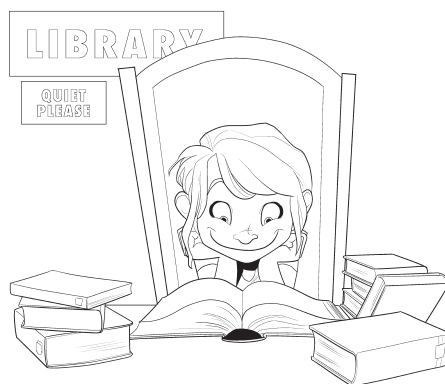
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#### Extra Activity:
