The Princess in the Tower

Adding 'es' to Nouns and Verbs

When we make a noun plural (meaning there is more than one), we usually just add **s**, for example: 1 *arm* – 2 *arms*. But if a noun ends in **s**, **ss**, **sh**, **ch**, **x** or **z**, we need to add **es**. Add **es** to the nouns below.

princess -	bus -
glass -	bunch -
dress -	beach -
dish -	box -

The same rule applies to verbs. Add **es** to the verbs below:

miss -	mix -
fix -	stretch -
wash -	touch -
crash -	buzz -
