

Kay Cottee's Adventures A Dash of This and a Dash of That...

A **dash** is a short line used to break up a sentence. It usually adds extra information to a main statement.

For example: I love fishing - particularly in the ocean!

Finish these sentences by using a dash to join extra information to a main statement.

Extra Information

- the last part of her trip.
- all 6 tonnes of it.
- that's about 45,000 kilometres.
- an intense fiery light.
- that's the height of a five storey building!
- because it would be sailing through some of the worst seas on earth.

Main Statements

She travelled 22,000 nautical miles - that's about 45,000 kilometres. The yacht was strengthened

4. Some waves were 14 metres high
5. The boat was practically surfing
6. She let off a distress flare
