


The Titanic

Planning an Explanation Text

Title

A how or why question such as 'How do Icebergs Form?'

Introduction

Write a simple general statement about icebergs.

Sequenced Statements

Describe the formation of the iceberg in detail. Use diagrams if possible.

Concluding statement

End the explanation by briefly explaining what has happened.

Resources

List the author, title and publisher of any resources you have used.
